Guidance Notes for Vehicles

Parking

The Dam Head Car Park is closed on the day

1. The Car Park at the Train Station is a Public car park and access to the lake can be made on foot Via the Path 5-10 Min, or why not take the Train. This Car Park will be full quite early and if so head for the Roundabout in the Village.
2. There will be a Ferocious Traffic Warden by the Monument directing traffic up the Hill to Horton Lodge School where a Kindly gentleman will direct you to a secure parking place and relieve you of £3 for the days Parking. (This money to go to the school funds as they are as poor as Sailability) The Dragon path takes you directly down to the lake a 10 min stroll. Last year this was hugely successful and we hope for the same response this year.
3. There are several reserved Disabled Places in the Village, Please ask the Traffic Warden for directions. Sailability has had to pay for these places and we are very sorry but a fee of £3 will be charged for the day.

Parking at the Lake is normally £3 and there are no concessions.

4. Mini-buses can be parked at the church in Lake road for a £5 fee and must be pre-booked, monies going to the church funds. **No Cars will be allowed to park here.**

5. **Team Members parking in the village or at the Hotel will incur a time penalty for their Team.**

Please help us to control the problems of Parking by using these facilities and ensuring that we do not cause problems for both the local residents and the Emergency services. **Car Sharing would help enormously and be very much appreciated. Thank you**
